Welcome to the Sauk Prairie Area Food Pantry. All patrons must sign cards for 2016. These cards will be used each time you come to the pantry during the year. All information on these cards is confidential and does not leave the pantry. This pantry serves all who qualify and does not discriminate on the basis of age, race, sex, religion, national origin, sexual orientation or disability.

Patrons must live within the Sauk Prairie School District area. Everyone must bring current proof of address each time they come to the pantry. This can be a utility bill, rental receipt, etc. issued within the last 30 days which shows your name and address. **ID's and a piece of mail or 2 different pieces of mail are needed the first month. After that, you must bring a piece of mail each month.** This will be strictly enforced. We can lose the privilege of receiving commodity food if it is not.

We provide supplemental assistance food for patrons once a month. All the food that we distribute comes from donations of food, or money with which to purchase food. Help us to be fair, take the posted limits, and don't ask for additional food or extra services. Bring your own bags, if possible.

Please park in the upper lot and walk down if you are able. This leaves the limited spaces in the lower lot for those who cannot manage the walk. We have volunteers to help you get your food to your vehicles.

There are five distributions each month. Food is received all during the month and shelves are restocked on a regular basis. **No distribution consistently has more food than any other distribution.** We have no control over the length of the wait for food or for the lack of a large indoor space in which to wait. Your cooperation and patience is appreciated both with the pantry volunteers and with one another. **Use of the pantry is a privilege, not a right.** We reserve the right to ask anyone causing a disturbance or problem to leave. We have existed to provide a service to the community for 34 years and we do so with pleasure. We are grateful to you for your cooperation and hope that this will be helpful and pleasant experience for everyone.
